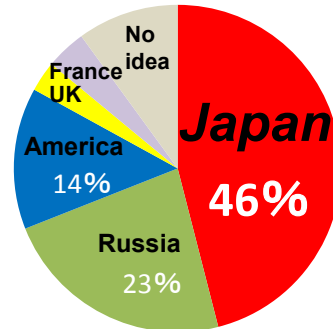


Opinion Poll: Image of Japan in India

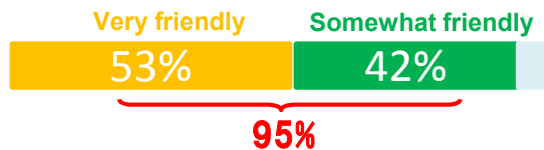
Relationship with Japan

Q. How do you think about the current state of relationship between Japan and India



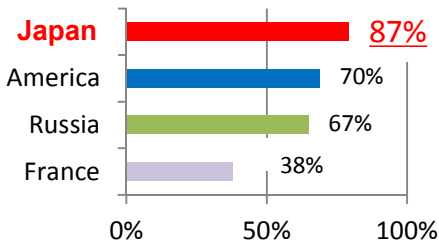
95% answered 'friendly'.

 - Sample Size : 1710 Opinion Leaders in 11 cities and 535 general Public (age 18 and over) in 5 cities in India
 - Methodology : face-to-face interviews
 - Survey Period : January ~ March 2016
- (NOTE) Percentages may not always add up to 100% due to rounding off figures or the acceptance of multiple answers from respondents.

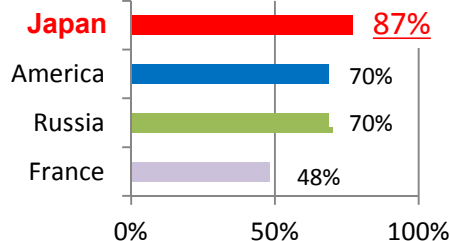
India's Important Partner

Q. Which of the following countries is CURRENTLY considered as important partner for India?

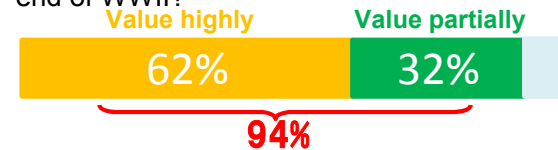


Q. Which of the following countries is considered as important partner for India in the FUTURE?



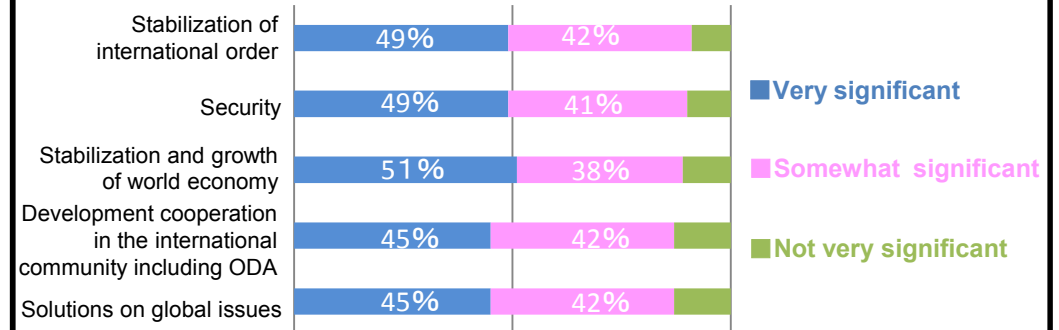
Japan's International Contribution

Q. How do you evaluate Japan's performance as peace-loving nation for 70 years since the end of WWII?

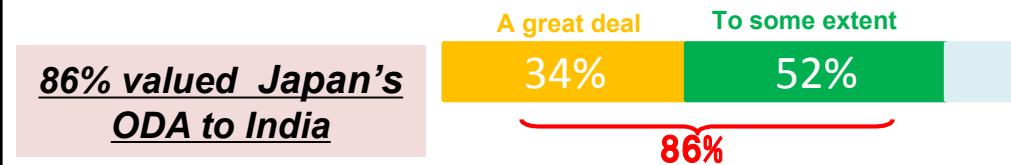


94% valued Japan's performance as peace-loving nation.

Q. What is your impression of Japan?

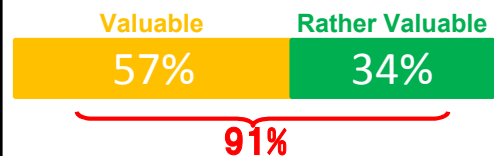
- OA country with strong economy and high technology
