

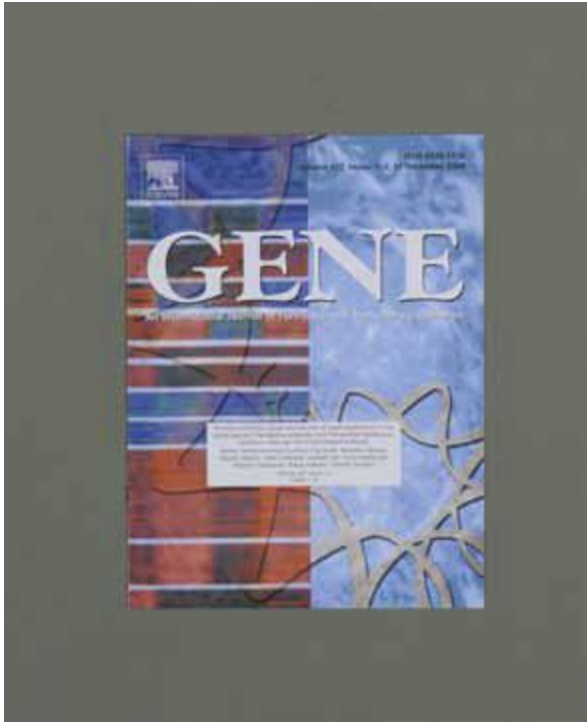
## Some of the Publications by His Majesty Emperor Akihito



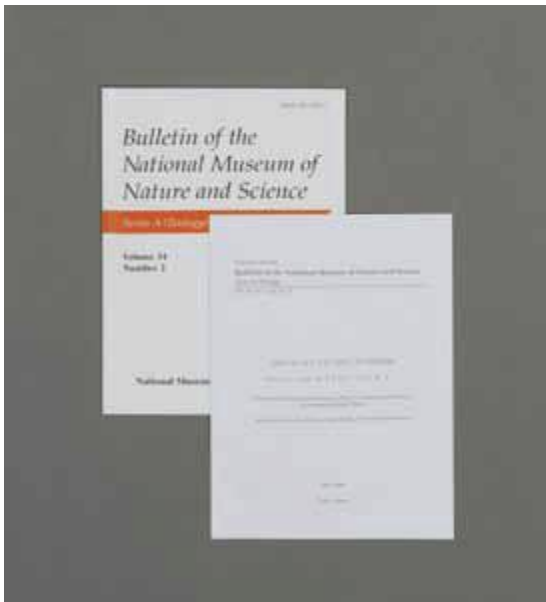
