Mitsubishi Electric is supplying the propulsion system for the rolling stocks; Nippon Signal is installing its Automated Fare Collection System and Signalling and Train Control System; and Mitsui & Co. has been roped in for the procurement of rail, which is manufactured by Nippon Steel & Sumitomo Metal.

Thus, Ahmedabad Metro indeed exemplifies the current strong relationship existing between Japan and India, unprecedentedly developed under the strong leadership of Prime Minister Abe and Prime Minister Modi.
