Remarks by Ambassador SUZUKI Satoshi at the Inauguration of Intelligent Transport System (ITS) on 6-lane Eastern Peripheral Expressway at ITS Control Room Building (EPE), Dasna (23 December, 2021)

Besides the financial assistance amounting to approximately 4.6 billion INR, Japan has supported the development of the institutional capacity for the operation and maintenance of expressways through JICA's technical assistance from 2013 to 2015. This has provided the foundation of today's operations of EPE as well as other expressways which are being developed across India under *Bharatmala Pariyojana*.

Quality connectivity is indispensable for better development of a nation. Japan always stands with India for enhancement and improvement of connectivity in the country. We will continue our cooperation in accordance with the MoC between the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways of India and the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism of Japan.

The upcoming year 2022 marks the 70th anniversary of Japan - India diplomatic relations. Thus, today's ceremony can be seen as a decorative figure of this promising year.

I would like to conclude my remarks by expressing my gratitude to all those who have dedicated their tireless efforts to make this excellent ITS a reality.
