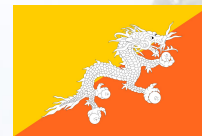


# The JET Programme CIR 2025 Application OPEN!!



The Japan Exchange and Teaching (JET) Programme started in 1987. It is implemented by the Japanese government and local authorities to promote grassroots international exchange between Japan and other countries. So far, more than 79,000 people have participated from 80 countries around the world.



## Job position

### Coordinator for International Relations (CIR)

Participants employed as CIRs are placed in international exchange departments of local authorities in Japan to handle interpretations, translations, planning international exchange program, support for foreign residents, etc.

## Eligibility

- Hold at least a Bachelor's degree or obtain such qualifications by July 2025.
- Be a Bhutan citizen.
- Have a functional command of Japanese (JLPT “N3” is a must).
- Have a driving licence. – Be both mentally and physically healthy.
- Not have lived in Japan for six or more years in total in the past ten years.
- Have a keen interest in Japan and be willing to deepen their knowledge and appreciation of Japan.



## General Conditions

### (1) Period of Participation

– Participation is for one-year starting from the day after arrival in Japan and may extend up to 3 years or in exceptional cases up to 5 years.

### (2) Remuneration

– Participants receive a remuneration of approximately 4.02 million yen (approx. Nu.2.24 million) for their first year of appointment.

### (3) Assignment

– Participants are assigned to Ama town, Shimane prefecture in Japan.
