List of Japanese Companies in India (as of October 2024)

The Embassy and Consulates-General of Japan in India and JETRO updated the List of Japanese Companies in India as of October 2024 with the cooperation of Japanese Chambers of Commerce and Industry and Japanese Associations across India. The summary of the result based on the voluntary survey is as follows:

The total number of Japanese companies (head offices, main branches, etc., of local subsidiaries) across India reached 1,434 companies (2023: 1,399 companies), and the total number of operational bases reached 5,205 bases (2023: 4,957 bases). Over half of all Japanese companies in India and approximately over one-third of all operational bases are in the manufacturing industry. Since 2023, 58 new companies have been counted as Japanese companies due to new investments, capital increases, equity expansions, etc., while 23 companies were removed from the previous survey's list due to mergers, withdrawals, capital reductions, etc.

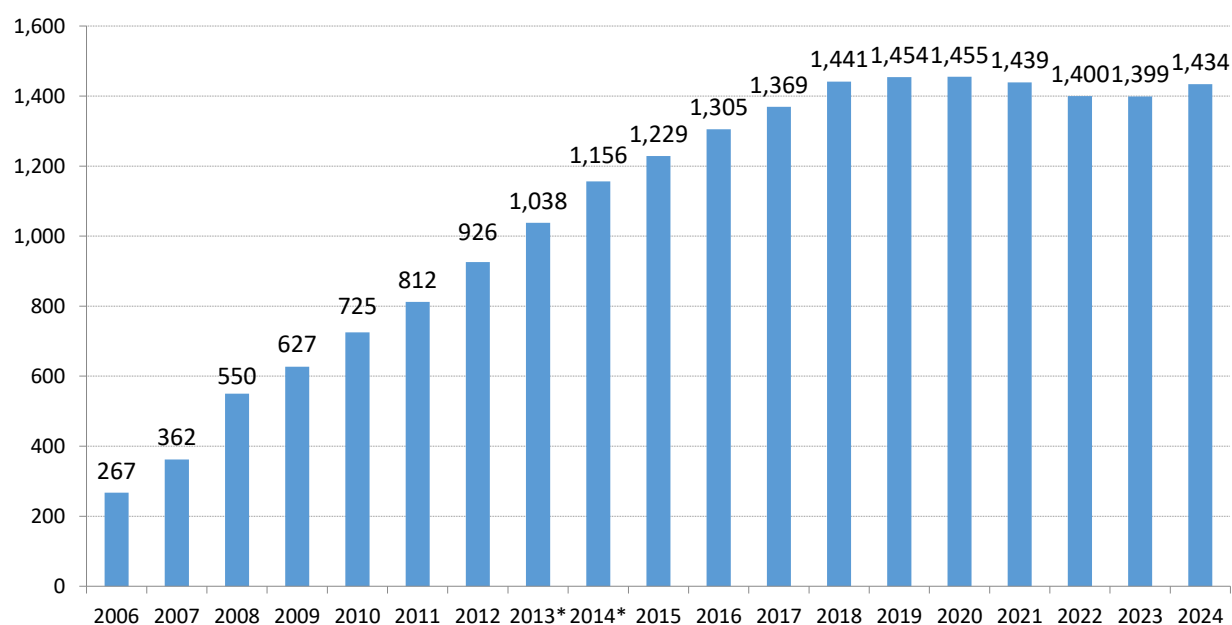

(Companies)

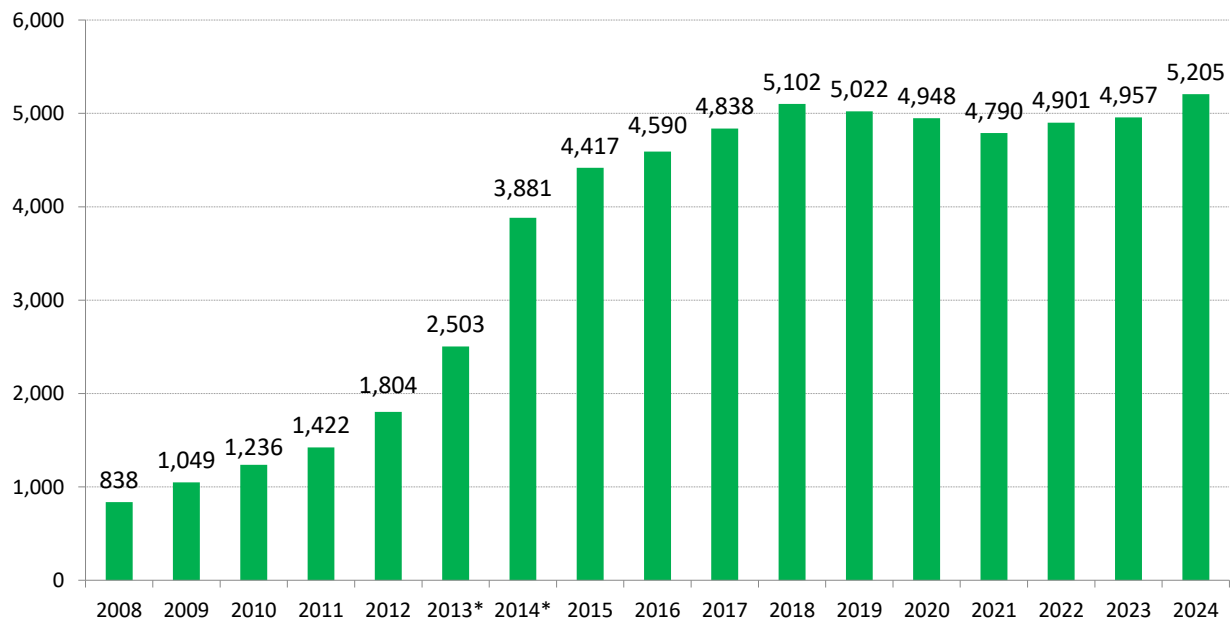

Head office of Indian Subsidiary (Wholly owned/Joint venture, its sub-subsidiary or sub-sub-subsidiaries) of a Japanese company (with direct or indirect shares of 10% or more by Japanese company), and 3. Business Enterprise founded in India by Japanese national(s) (Japanese share is 10% or more).

(Note 1): Oct 2010 onwards, being based on the defined criteria of the Japanese Business Establishments in India as (1) Head office, (2) Factory, and (3) Branches etc also regulate to include establishment without regular-basis Japanese staffs, it is observed a slight decline of Japanese Business Establishments in some areas.

(Note 2): In order to capture the business scenario of Japanese Companies in India more precisely, all the Business Establishments (except franchisee and dealer) irrespective of regular-basis Japanese staffs are taken into consideration Oct. 2013 onwards. Consequently, some areas show a significant increase in numbers.

(Note 3): The increase in the number of Japanese business establishments during the one year (October 2013 to October 2014) under the survey is very large, mainly due to the following reasons: In case where a Japanese company forms a JV with an Indian partner, the newly formed JV will also have the already established direct branch offices of that Indian partner, which will result in the immediate increase of the total number of business establishments. There are several such cases found during the survey, especially in insurance and transport sectors. There were also quite a number of Japanese business establishments which have not been captured in our previous surveys.

(Note 4): The number of establishments in Delhi and Haryana is mentioned separately for 2013,2014 and 2015.

(Note 5): The number of Japanese companies and establishments in 2013 and 2014 has been revised at the time of survey for 2015.

(Note 6): Due to the outbreak of COVID-19, there were companies which were unable to answer the survey. Hence, the data of the mentioned companies in 2019 was complemented by using 2018's data or web-based information. The decrease in the number of Japanese establishments during the one year (October 2018 to October 2019) under the survey is very large while the number of companies increase, mainly due to reorganization, the companies which became exception for the survey by decrease of Japanese shares, etc. which surpassed the number of increased establishments by new companies.

(Note 7): The increase in the number of Japanese business establishments during the one year (October 2021 to October 2022) under the survey is very large, mainly due to the new opening of establishments by already existing companies
